- 1. George Gardet NV Brut Champagne**
Rich, nutty flavoursome Champagne, made in a style similar to Krug.

- 2. Pol Roger NV Brut Champagne**
Winston Churchill's favourite, so much so that when he died, Pol Roger put a black band around its label.

- 3. Pure Sauvignon Blanc***
Vin de Pays d'Oc
A pure, clean dry wine full of cut grass aromas, kiwi fruit and gooseberries balanced by a citrus tang.

- 4. Viognier L'Aristocrate***
Vin de Pays, France
Ripe, soft and fruity with a hint of spiced apricot and peach.

- 5. Pinot Grigio, Villa Sandi, Italy**
Very bright pale straw yellow. Marked fruity and flowery nose reminiscent of the countryside in summer. A dry round and flavoursome taste. A well structured wine with a warm and well balanced finish.

- 6. Chenin Blanc, Avondale Estate (Organic)**
Paarl, South Africa
Quite simply one of the finest and most direct of South African Chenin Blancs. Here you can really taste Chenin's signature characters of honey and grapefruit.

Cave de Pfaffenheim, Alsace
Dry yet very fruity, it combines spicy lychee characters with a mouth filling richness. Heady stuff.

Broad spectrum of tropical fruit notes, cereal and creamy oak. Balanced, crisp finish.

- 9. Sauvignon Gris, 'Kadum Vineyard'**
Leyda, Chile
Quite a rare grape to find and similar to Sauvignon Blanc in many ways. Very forward, pungent and grassy with a fresh elderflower and blackcurrant leaf character.

- 10. Sauvignon Blanc, Kuki Estate**
Marlborough, New Zealand
Intensely herbaceous with oodles of ripe elderflower fruit. Ranked by Oz Clarke as one of the best Kiwi Sauvignons around.

11. **Chablis Testut**
France
Domaine Testut are arguably the finest producers of Chablis: their wines often contain a richer, more mineral character than their neighbours'. Zesty, steely and fresh with a long finish.

12. **Sauvignon Blanc**
Bouchard Finlayson, Walker Bay, South Africa
Zesty, uplifted nose of crushed herbaceous fruits and green leaf. We like to think that we may have picked some of the grapes that go into this one!

13. **Elysium Black Muscat, A Quady, California**
Lovely ripe blackberry and bilberry fruit, vibrant and fresh clean fruit palate.

14. **Merlot, El Picador, Chile ***
Dark, red, dense and jammy with plum, spice and baked cherry flavours

15. **Shiraz/Viognier L'Aristocrate**
Vin de Pays, France
Dark, ripe and full bodied with a lovely core of sweet black fruits, liquorice, pepper and spice.

16. **Beaujolais Villages**
Gry Sablon, France
Proper Beaujolais, made by one of Robert Parker's top 10 wineries in this warm Burgundian region. Here the local Gamay grape makes softly fruity reds that are elegant and vibrant. Gry Sablon wines are renowned for their structure and intensity.

17. **Malbec 'Lunta' Mendel, Argentina**
Opaque, dark and brooding Malbec, made by one of the top producers. Inky black, spicy black fruits and a strong hint of coffee and liquorice.

18. **Shiraz 'Pitchfork' Chalk Hill,**
McLaren Vale, Australia
A wonderfully full and creamy mouthful of jammy red fruits and vanilla pod spice.

19. **Pinot Noir, Haegelin, Alsace, France**
Ripe, smooth and moreish, a rare red from one of the sunniest spots in France. In style it is like a cross between Burgundy and a New Zealand Pinot.

20. **Rioja Reserva, Muerza**
Magnificent concentration of ripe, moreish fruits, sturdy structure and beautifully weaved tannins.

21. **Cabernet Franc/Merlot 'Red Horse Blend'**
Irvine, Australia
Outstanding ripe, smooth and brooding red wine, very complex and a worthy opponent to any top Pomerol.

22. **Syrah ' Camissa', Avondale,**
South Africa (Organic)
Wonderfully rich, smooth and supple Syrah with layers of cracked pepper, warm red fruits, integrated vanilla oak and ripe tannins.

Bordeaux, France
Lovely, complex and flavoursome red, with layers of blackcurrant, raspberry and integrated oak.

Cloudy Bay

Founded in 1973 by David Hoehnen, this is one of the truly iconic labels in the wine world. Its wines are sought after by collectors and consumers alike. Produced from grapes grown around the majestic Marlborough Valley in South Island, its wines are aromatic, fresh and concentrated.

24. **Pelorus NV Brut (sparkling wine)**
Famous for its great Sauvignon, this is Cloudy Bay's answer to Champagne, and what a great wine it is. Soft, creamy and elegant.
