- 21. Malbec, Gouguenheim, Argentina**
Big warming style of Malbec, dark in the glass with a brooding hint of liquorice and baked plums.
£17.00 per Bottle
- 22. Valpolicella Superiore, Zenato**
Veneto, Italy
A very classy Valpol with a great pedigree – ripe cherry fruit, hints of hedgerow and bramble, balanced acidity and an appealing freshness.

- 23. Rioja Reserva, Muerza**
Spain
Magnificent concentration of ripe, moreish fruits, sturdy structure and beautifully weaved tannins.

- 24. Merlot CJ Pask**
New Zealand
Ripe fully flavoured fruit is traditionally warm fermented and then aged in oak for softening, complexing and completing this wine.

Lovely, complex and flavoursome red, with layers of blackcurrant, raspberry and integrated oak.

- 3. Prosecco 'Pure', Veneto, Italy**
Soft, fruity and dry with hints of melon, grape and almond.

- 4. Pelorus NV Brut**
Famous for its great Sauvignon, this is Cloudy Bay's answer to Champagne, and what a great wine it is. Soft, creamy and elegant.

- 5. Sauvignon Blanc, Le Charme Vin de Pays d'Oc**
Crisp, zesty Sauvignon, made from hand-picked grapes and oozing pungent gooseberry and passion fruit flavours.

Very bright pale straw yellow. Marked fruity and flowery nose reminiscent of the countryside in summer. A dry round and flavoursome taste.

Rich, creamy and balanced with layers of oak, cereal, stonefruits and citrus – bordering on Meursault in style'.
